








We Are Committed To Student Success!

That dedication is reflected in the quality of teaching, thoughtful advising, and academic support from our faculty and staff.




Welcome from the Provost's Office

Student communication with professors is very important part of academic success.

- ✓ Every course has a syllabus provided within **Canvas**, our learning management platform
 - Course expectation
 - Class schedule
 - Contact information for faculty member
- ✓ Students can contact professors by email
- ✓ We encourage students to visit their faculty member during office hours, specific time periods for student to visit in office or on Zoom.
- ✓ Professors will provide feedback to students on their work, provide grades with Canvas and share additional academic concerns through Navigate.

Students should monitor Canvas and Navigate closely and watch for email communication from faculty.



CLR tutors focus sessions on discussions and demonstrations of key concepts and processes, using external examples to assist students in grasping and applying material.



Our hours for Fall 2022 are:


